



Dear Parents

The P&F are holding a Kids Colour Run on Friday the 1st November as a major fundraiser for 2024. This exciting event celebrates friendship, physical and mental health and, most importantly, having a whole lot of fun with a kaleidoscope of smiles, laughter and vibrant display of unity.

The funds raised during these events will be directed towards boosting our Digital Technology program by acquiring essential equipment and software, as well as enriching our Performing Arts programs. Additionally, we will acquire valuable learning and teaching resources for various subject areas, benefiting our entire school community. More details about the Colour Run will be provided prior to the day, however, below is some general information about the event:

What Should My Child Wear? Students will need to come to the school on this day dressed for the Colour Run. They will need to wear a **WHITE** t-shirt, old shorts/pants and shoes that you do not mind if they get messy. Additionally, ALL students will need to bring a towel on the day (they can get a bit messy and there will be light water mist sprayed). The colour powder is not toxic but will stain clothes (the bright colours show up best on white t-shirts!). Asthmatics should have their inhalers with them. Children may bring their own goggles from home. For any child who wishes to join in the fun of the day but prefers to not have colours thrown onto them, we ask that they wear a plain black t-shirt so that they may be easily identified.

Is the Colour Safe? The colour powder used is non-toxic, biodegradable, skin safe and environmentally friendly. It is made of high-quality cornflour with permitted food colours.

What is the event timing? The Colour Run is being held during school time. Kindy-Year Two students will participate from 1:25pm and when they are finished, Year Three to Year Six students will run. Parents are welcome to come along, watch and cheer from the spectator's area. However, we gently remind Parents that the Colour Run is a school event and students will not be able to join their parents until the end of the school day.

What happens on the day? A course will be set up weaving through both senior and junior ovals. Students will run laps of the ovals navigating various obstacles and stations, involving water and a kaleidoscope of colours. Anything squirted by our parent volunteers and staff will be from the chest down. Music will also be played throughout the run to keep the children pumped!

How does my Child Fundraise? Using the sponsor sheet, students are asked to seek sponsorship donations from family, friends, and their local community. We would like to encourage each child to raise at least \$15. If you raise more than this, of course, it will be gratefully received. Donors can sponsor students with cash which the students collect and return to their class teacher by Wednesday 30th October.

What is the Fund-Raising Prize? We have amazing prizes for the highest fundraisers and incredible lucky draw prizes open to any student who returns their Colour Run Sponsor Sheet and monies by the due date. Lucky draw prizes include cool tote bags filled with goodies kindly donated by Armando Intersport and, for three lucky students, each a \$100 Woolworths gift card kindly donated by Mr. Terry Healy MLA.
